17 **AN ACT Authorizing Husson College to Confer**
18 **a Degree of Bachelor of Science in Nursing.**

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

21 Husson College; granted power to confer Bachelor of
22 Science in Nursing degree. In addition to the rights,
23 privileges and powers heretofore granted by any prior Act to
24 Husson College, an institution of higher education located
25 in Bangor, County of Penobscot, State of Maine, Husson Col-
26 lege is hereby granted authority to confer a degree of Bach-
27 elor of Science in Nursing upon all who shall satisfactorily
28 complete courses of academic and clinical study jointly pre-
29 scribed by its trustees and Eastern Maine Medical Center.
30 Clinical studies shall be prescribed within the guidelines
31 of appropriate institutional and professional accrediting
32 bodies and shall be provided by Eastern Maine Medical Cen-
33 ter.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill will authorize Husson College to confer 4 year degrees in Nursing, Bachelor of Science. This course of study will be coordinated with Eastern Maine Medical Center where the clinical courses will be given. Classroom courses will be given on the Husson College campus. This undertaking is necessitated by the shortage of professional nurses in the central and eastern Maine area.
