26 27 28 29 30 31 32 33	School administrative units under current law have the authority to determine the grade level placement of a child from grades 1 through 12. In other words, the school unit may advance a child to any grade, in grades 1 through 12. This amendment extends that local option to kindergarten through grade 12. For school units which do not have a kindergarten, the minimum school entrance age would remain age 6 years by October 15th.
