20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

21 25 MRSA §2803, sub-§5-A is enacted to read:

22 5-A. Salary reimbursement. To provide, with the
23 approval of the commissioner, for the reimbursement of
24 municipalities, counties and corrections agencies for the
25 salaries paid to municipal or county law enforcement offi-
26 cers and corrections officers during their attendance at the
27 academy as required by section 2805;

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STATEMENT OF FACT

The current rules established by the board of trustees for the Maine Criminal Justice Academy provide for the reimbursement of corrections officers' salaries by the academy during the period of attendance. Reimbursement should also be required for the salaries of municipal and county law enforcement officers.

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
