6	COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1891, L.D.1877, Bill,
7	"AN ACT to Provide Retired Teachers, State Employees and
8	Beneficiaries with a Cost-of-living Increase."
9 10	Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:
11 12 13 14 15 16 17 18 19 20	'Sec. 1. Retirement allowances. Notwithstanding the Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 1128, subsection 1, monthly retirement allowances of retired teachers, state employees or their beneficiaries shall be increased by an additional one-time increase of $50^{\circ}$ for each full year of the member's creditable service. Recipients of survivor or disability benefits or any other recipient whose benefit is based on criteria other than length of creditable service shall receive instead an additional 2% above the regular percentage increase.
21	Sec. 2. Optional methods of payment; reduced bene-
22	fits. In the event that a benefit recipient receives a
23	reduced retirement benefit in accordance with options set
24	out in the Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 1126, the
25	monthly retirement allowance of that recipient shall be
26	increased by the amount provided in section 1, reduced by
27	the same percentage by which the recipient's retirement
28	allowance has been reduced.
29	Sec. 3. Supplemental cost-of-living increase; eligi-
30	bility. The increase provided by sections 1 and 2 shall be
31	applied to the retirement allowance of all retirees who have
32	been retired for at least 6 months prior to the date that
33	the increase becomes payable. Beneficiaries of deceased
34	retirees shall be eligible for the supplemental cost-
35	of-living increase at the same time the deceased retiree
36	would have become eligible.
37	Sec. 4. Supplemental cost-of-living increase; calcula-
38	tion and payment. The increase provided in sections 1 and 2

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shall be determined after calculation of the automatic adjustment in the retirement allowance described in the
Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 1128, subsection 1, paragraph A and shall be payable beginning in September, 1982.

6 Sec. 5. Participating local districts. Participating 7 local districts may provide for the increase described in sections 1 to 4 in retirement allowances being paid to their З 9 former employees or beneficiaries by supplying the board of 10 trustees with a certified copy of its action and a statement 11 of agreement of payment of costs.

12 Sec. 6. Appropriations; allocations. The following 13 funds are appropriated from the General Fund and allocated 14 from the Highway Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

24	tion and allocation, there will be
25	a cost to other funds of \$297,123

## 27 STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment provides a one-time across-the-board increase in retirement allowances to retired state employees, teachers and their beneficiaries. The increase is based on the number of full years of creditable service the

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2 employee earned under the Maine State Retirement System. Persons receiving reduced benefits under the various options 3 offered by the Maine State Retirement System shall have this 4 supplemental increase reduced by the same percentage as 5 their regular benefits. The increase provided by this 6 amendment will be calculated after the addition of the ad-7 justment provided by the Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 1128, subsection 1, and will be payable as of September, 1982. To be eligible recipients must have been retired for 8 9 10 11 6 months. Provision is made for participating local districts to offer the additional increase. 12
