19 20 21 22 23	Sec. 1. Retirement allowances. Notwithstanding the Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 1128, subsection 1 monthly retirement allowances of retired teachers, statemployees or their beneficiaries shall be increased by \$ for each year of the members' creditable service.		
24 25 26	Sec. 2. Appropriations; allocations. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund and allocated from the Highway Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.
