13 14	Whereas, the Maine Bid Preference Law has resulted in retaliation against Maine businesses by other states; and
15 16 17	Whereas, the normal effective date for this law of 90 days after adjournment is likely to result in loss of opportunity to bid in other states by Maine businesses; and
18 19 20	Whereas, emergency enactment will preserve their opportunities and thereby, provide economic benefits for the State; and
21 22 23 24 25	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,
26 27	Further amend the bill by inserting before the Statement of Fact the following:
28 29	'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.'
