18	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

To sell at retail in state store in original packages and for eash, either over the counte or by shipment to points within the State, wine, exceptable wine, and spirits of all kinds for consumption off the premises at state stores to be operated under the direction of the commission. All such sales shall be for cash, exceptant, at the one authorized special discount store, credit authorizes the holder to charge goods or services.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill allows the Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages to accept payment by use of major credit cards only at the special discount state store in Kittery.

Most sales at the Kittery store are to individual travelers, either entering or leaving the State, and most people when traveling now use credit cards. We now lose many sales at this state store because of the cash only requirement.

The State of New Hampshire accepts major credit cards and this has created a competition problem in this area.
