COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1921, L.D. 1903, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to the Compensation of Public Utilities'
Commissioners."

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the
enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 2 MRSA §6-A, sub-§§1 and 2, as repealed and
replaced by PL 1981, c. 452, §3, are repealed and the fol-
lowing enacted in their place:

1. Chairman. The salary of the chairman of the com-
mission shall be \$2,500 more than the salary of a member.

2. Commission members. The salary of members of the
commission shall be as follows:

A. Beginning January 1, 1983, it shall be 90% of the
salary of a District Judge;

B. Beginning January 1, 1984, it shall be 95% of the
salary of a District Judge; and

C. Beginning January 1, 1985, it shall be the same as
the salary of a District Judge.

Sec. 2. 2 MRSA §6-A, sub-§4, as enacted by PL 1981, c.
452, §3, is amended to read:

4. Legislative approval. Notwithstanding any other
provision of law, and except as provided in subsections 1
and 2, the pay ranges and steps for the state officials
listed in this section shall not be changed without legis-
lative approval.'

1 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1921, L.D. 1903

2 STATEMENT OF FACT

3 This amendment establishes the salaries of the members
4 of the Public Utilities Commission as an increasing percent
5 of the salary of a Judge of the District Courts; and the
6 salary of the chairman of the commission at \$2,500 more than
7 the members. Under current salary rates and assuming parti-
8 cipation in the Maine State Retirement System, the resulting
9 salaries would be:
