Amend the amendment by striking out all of the 4th and
5th paragraphs after the title which relate to that part
designated "§6", subsection 5, and inserting in their place
the following:

'Further amend the bill in that part designated "§6" by
striking out all of subsection 5 and inserting in its place
the following:

5. Range 86. The salaries of the following state
officials and employees shall be within the salary range 86:

- Director of Labor Standards;
- Deputy Chief of the State Police;
- Director of State Lotteries;
- State Archivist;
- Director of Maine Geological Survey;
- Executive Director, Maine Land Use Regulation Commis-
sion; and
- Chairman, Maine Employment Securities Commission.'
