COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 813, L.D. 1909, Bill,
7 "AN ACT Revising Executive Salary Ranges."

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Amend the bill by inserting at the beginning of the
first line after the enacting clause the abbreviation and
figure 'Sec. 1.'

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Further amend the bill in that part designated "§6" in
the first paragraph by striking out all of the 3rd under-
lined sentence and inserting in its place the following:

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'The salary ranges shall be as provided by law; except that,
for the purposes of this section, each salary range shall be
increased by 2 steps in addition to and in the same manner
of increase as the steps in the range otherwise provided by
law.'

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Further amend the bill in that part designated "§6" in
subsection 3 by striking out all of the last 2 lines and
inserting in their place the following:

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'Director, Energy Resources Office;
Public Advocate; and
Commissioner of Defense and Veterans' Services.'

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Further amend the bill in that part designated "§6" in
subsection 5 by striking out all of the 3rd line (page 3,
line 19 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'Adjutant General;'

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Further amend the bill in that part designated "§6" in
subsection 5 by striking out all of the 2nd, 3rd, 4th and
5th lines from the end and inserting in their place the fol-
lowing:

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35

'Executive Director, Maine Land Use Regulation Commission;
and
Chairman, Maine Employment Securities Commission.'

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2 Further amend the bill in that part designated "§6" in
3 subsection 6 by striking out all of the 5th, 6th and 7th
4 lines and inserting in their place the following:

5 'Executive Director, Historic Preservation Commission;
6 Members, Maine Employment Security Commission; and
7 Deputy Adjutant General (Director of Military Bureau).'

8 Further amend the bill in that part designated "§6" in
9 subsection 7 by striking out all of the last line (page 4,
10 line 13 in L.D.).

11 Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before
12 the statement of fact the following:

13 'Sec. 2. Transitional clause. The Commissioner of
14 Personnel shall evaluate and assign a salary range to the
15 positions of: Chief Boiler Inspector and Supervising Elevator
16 Inspector; Dispute Resolution Specialist; and the Director
17 of the Real Estate Commission. Notwithstanding the
18 salary range which may be assigned, an incumbent of one of
19 the named positions at the time this Act becomes law shall
20 not be given a decrease in pay.

21 Sec. 3. Effective date. This Act shall take effect
22 January 6, 1983.

23 STATEMENT OF FACT

24 This amendment:

25 1. Corrects the language regarding the addition of 2
26 pay steps for executive salaries under current law;

27 2. Raises the Adjutant General from range 86 to range
28 89, and changes his designation to "Commissioner of Defense
29 and Veterans' Services;"

30 3. Deletes the "Executive Director of the Maine Labor
31 Relations Board" from Title 2, section 6, as his salary is
32 set and adjusted under Title 26, section 968;

33 4. Raises the Deputy Adjutant General from range 83 to

2 range 85, and identifies him as Director of the Military
3 Bureau;

4 5. Ensures that the incumbents of the 3 other posi-
5 tions removed from having their salary ranges set by the
6 Legislature and adjusted by the Governor cannot be given a
7 pay decrease if their positions are assigned to a lower pay
8 range by the Commissioner of Personnel; and

9 6. Provides that this Act shall take effect on the day
10 after the inauguration of the Governor in 1983.
