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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1936, L.D.1916, Bill,
"AN ACT to Ensure Continuance of the Residential Conserva-
tion Service."

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Amend the bill in section 1 by adding at the end a new
paragraph to read:

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'Until the director promulgates new rules under this
paragraph, the previously existing federal rules and
any state rules implementing them shall be considered
state rules with full force.'

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Further amend the bill in the last paragraph before the
Statement of Fact by adding at the end a new sentence to
read:

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'In order to assure continuity of the program, the previous
rules under the federal program shall remain in effect until
replaced by new state rules.'

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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To assure continuity of the Residential Conservation
Service program, this amendment keeps the rules from the
federal program in effect after the federal program ends or
is significantly cut back until new state rules are adopted
to take their place.
