Further amend the bill by inserting at the beginning of 3 the first line after the enacting clause the following: 'Sec. 3.' 5 STATEMENT OF FACT The amendment changes existing statute relating to anatomical gifts and also alters the method by which a license holder may elect to become an "organ donor." 6
