	AN ACT to Revise the Allocation of Funds to Provide Photographic Nonalterable Driver's Licenses and Indentification Cards.
	Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
	Whereas, the next fiscal year will begin before the 90-day period terminates, and funds must be made available prior to that time to carry out the intent of this legislation; and
	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Public Law 1981, chapter 506 provides for a photographic, nonalterable driver's licenses and identification care to be effective July 1, 1982. In order for this program to be put into effect certain planning, developing of forms, procedures and hiring of personnel must go into effect prior to July 1, 1982. The present law, as it is written, does not permit the expenditure of funds until after July 1, 1982. In addition, the allocation of funds are normally provided to the Secretary of State, Motor Vehicle Division, as unallocated.
