11 Amend the amendment in section 1 under the caption
12 "CORRECTIONS, DEPARTMENT OF" by striking out all of
13 the first line (page 1, line 26 in amendment) and inserting
14 in its place the following:

24 ing in its place the following:

25 Provides for alcohol abuse ser-
26 vices to clients in the correc-
27 tional system. It is the legis-
28 lative intent that the Depart-
29 ment of Finance and Administra-
30 tion and the Department of Cor-
31 rections shall maintain one ac-
32 count for funds allocated from
33 this fund and it shall be the
34 responsibility of the Department
35 of Corrections to use these
36 funds in the following areas and
37 in the amounts indicated:

11 Department of Finance and Admin-
12 istration and the Department of
13 Human Services shall maintain
14 one account for funds allocated
15 from this fund and it shall be
16 the responsibility of the
17 Department of Human Services to
18 use these funds in the following
19 areas and in the amounts indi-

19 tion "HUMAN SERVICES, DEPARTMENT OF" in that part
20 relating to "All Other" by striking out all of the 3rd para-
21 graph (page 2, lines 35 to 38 in amendment).

22 Further amend the amendment in section 1 under the cap-
23 tion "MENTAL HEALTH AND MENTAL RETARDATION,
24 DEPARTMENT OF" in that part relating to "All Other" by
25 striking out all of the blocked paragraph (page 3, lines 8
26 and 9 in amendment) and inserting in its place the follow-
27 ing:

28 'Provides for alcohol abuse ser-
29 vices. The allocation recog-
30 nizes that \$89,000 remains in
31 the fiscal year 1982 allocation.
32 These resources are available to
33 the department to provide
34 \$34,000 for alcoholism services
35 in mental retardation programs;
36 \$25,000 to Bangor Mental Health
37 Institute; \$25,000 for Augusta
38 Mental Health Institute for
39 alcoholism services in programs
40 in those institutions; and
41 \$5,000 is for training in the
42 existing homebuilders program.

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3 The contracts for these services
4 will be made in fiscal year 1982
5 but will provide services in
6 fiscal year 1982 and 1983. It
7 is the legislative intent that
8 the Department of Finance and
9 Administration and the Department
10 of Mental Health and Mental
11 Retardation shall maintain one
12 account for funds allocated from
13 this fund and it shall be the
14 responsibility of the Department
15 of Mental Health and Mental
16 Retardation to use these funds
17 in the following areas and in
18 the amounts indicated:

31 STATEMENT OF FACT

32 This amendment lists the programs which will be funded
33 in whole or in part by the Alcoholism Prevention, Education,
34 Treatment and Research Fund. It also recognizes that funds
35 allocated in fiscal year 1982 may be contracted during
36 fiscal year 1982 which will provide services in fiscal year
37 1982 and fiscal year 1983 by the Department of Educational
38 and Cultural Services and the Department of Mental Health
39 and Mental Retardation. Their fiscal year 1983 allocations
40 were reduced to reflect this decision.

3 This amendment also adds language to provide
4 that the Department of Finance and Administration and each
5 department may account for the funds allocated by this Act
6 in one account.
