9 the fiscal year 1982 allocation.
10 These resources are available to
11 the department to provide
12 \$34,000 for alcoholism services
13 in mental retardation programs;
14 \$25,000 to Bangor Mental Health
15 Institute; \$25,000 for Augusta
16 Mental Health Institute for
17 alcoholism services in programs
18 in those institutions; and
19 \$5,000 is for training in the
20 existing homebuilders program.
21 The contracts for these services
22 will be made in fiscal year 1982
23 but will provide services in
24 fiscal year 1982 and 1983. The

3 STATEMENT OF FACT


4 This amendment lists the programs which will be funded
5 in whole or in part by the Alcoholism Prevention, Education,
6 Treatment and Research Fund. It also recognizes that funds
7 allocated in fiscal year 1982 may be contracted during
8 fiscal year 1982 which will provide services in fiscal year
9 1982 and fiscal year 1983 by the Department of Educational
10 and Cultural Services and the Department of Mental Health
11 and Mental Retardation. Their fiscal year 1983 allocations
12 were reduced to reflect this decision.
