2 STATE OF MAINE 3 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES (Filing No. H-685) 4 110TH LEGISLATURE 5 SECOND REGULAR SESSION COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1984, L.D. 1956, Bill, 6 "AN ACT Relating to State Entitlement of Certain School 7 8 Administrative Districts." 9 Amend the bill by adding before the enacting clause the following: 10 11 'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature 12 do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment 13 unless enacted as emergencies; and 14 Whereas, federal impact aid appropriations have been 15 drastically reduced in fiscal year 1981-82; and 16 Whereas, under the state subsidy formula impact aid is 17 subtracted from the school units' subsidy; and 18 Whereas, these 2 factors combine to cause a double 19 reduction in outside aid; and Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these 20 facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Consti-21 tution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public 22 23 peace, health and safety; now, therefore,' 24 Further amend the bill by adding before the Statement 25 26 of Fact the following: 'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in 27 the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved. 28 **Fiscal Note** 29 The bill will cost the State \$300,000 in fiscal year 30 1981-82 and \$480,000 in fiscal year 1982-83. 31
