	21 22 23	Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
	24 25 26 27	Whereas, prompt determination of the cost of the Maine Forestry District is necessary in order to establish the tax to be raised within each member municipality and the unorganized territory in fiscal year 1982-83; and
	28 29 30 31 32	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Consti- tution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,
	33	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

1 Maine Forestry District cost. In accordance with the 2 Revised Statutes, Title 12, section 1601, the Legislature 3 determines that the cost of the Maine Forestry District for 4 fiscal year 1982-83 is \$3,238,087.

5 **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in 6 the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.

STATEMENT OF FACT

8 This bill establishes the cost of the Maine Forestry 9 District for fiscal year 1982-83, as required by the Revised 10 Statutes, Title 12, section 1601.
