## 28 STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill requires local participating districts where employees are also covered by Social Security to offer the option of coverage under only one system. It also establishes provisions for the withdrawal of members and their contributions, for rejoining and for the status of retirement credit and contributions during the period of withdrawal. The bill allows flexibility to employees to decide whether to join the state system or the state and the federal systems.
