15 **AN ACT to Establish Priorities for**
16 **the Aid to Families with Dependent**
17 **Children Program in Response to**
18 **Federal Cutbacks.**

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

21 **Sec. 1. Policy and intent.** It is the policy of the
22 State to provide the highest level of assistance possible to
23 eligible recipients of the Aid to Families with Dependent
24 Children Program, to counteract the effects of inflation and
25 restrictions in federal eligibility regulations and to
26 insure an income sufficient to safeguard the health and
27 safety of eligible children and families.

28 It is the intent of this chapter, notwithstanding any
29 other provision of law, that the amounts appropriated for
30 the Aid to Families with Dependent Children Program account
31 for the biennium 1982-83, and in following years shall not
32 be transferred from that account but shall be carried for-
33 ward and expended for the same purpose.
