SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 2015, L.D. 1985, Bill,
"AN ACT to Provide for a Comprehensive Career and Occupa-

Amend the title by striking out the word "Carreer" and
inserting in its place the word 'Career'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the beginning of
the first line after the enacting clause (page 1, line 21 in
L.D.) the abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend the bill by inserting before the State-
ment of Fact the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriation. The following funds are
appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes
of this Act.
