HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 855, L.D. 1992, Bill,
"AN ACT to Accept Relinquishment of Exclusive Federal Juris-
diction Over Marshall Point Light Station in the Town of St.
George."

Amend the Bill by inserting before the enacting clause
the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature
do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment
unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, legislation is needed to accept concurrent
legislative jurisdiction with the Federal Government over
Marshall Point Light Station in the Town of St. George; and

Whereas, concurrent jurisdiction is needed at the ear-
liest possible time in order to provide necessary services
during the forthcoming summer season; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these
facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Consti-
tution of Maine and require the following legislation as
immediately necessary for the preservation of the public
peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Further amend the Bill by inserting at the end before
the statement of fact the following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in
the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.'
