6 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 860, L.D.1993, Bill, 7 "AN ACT to Authorize Municipalities to Establish and Main-8 tain Employment Offices."

9 Amend the Bill in that part designated "<u>\$1084.</u>" by 10 striking out all of subsection 1 and inserting in its place 11 the following:

12 '1. Authorization. The legislative body of a munici-13 pality may authorize its municipal officers or their desig-14 nee to enter into an agreement, not financed by the State, 15 with the Director of the Maine Job Service or the Executive 16 Director of the Bureau of Employment Security for the pur-17 pose of providing job services or job service facilities, or 18 both.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment clarifies the wording in the bill and makes it clear that the State shall not be required to fund any employment services provided by municipalities pursuant to the Revised Statutes, Title 26, section 1084.
