32 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

1 Spruce Budworm Spray Project Cost. In accordance with 2 the Revised Statutes, Title 12, section 8426, the Legis-3 lature determines the cost of the 1982 Spruce Budworm Spray 4 Project is \$7,500,000.

5 **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in 6 the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.
