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17 **AN ACT to Establish the Cost of the**  
18 **1982 Spruce Budworm Spray Project.**  
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20 **Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts of the Legislature  
21 do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment  
22 unless enacted as emergencies; and

23 Whereas, prompt determination of the cost of the spruce  
24 budworm spray project is necessary in order to establish the  
25 preproject taxes to be assessed on landowners in the spray  
26 program area; and

27 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these  
28 facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Consti-  
29 tution of Maine and require the following legislation as  
30 immediately necessary for the preservation of the public  
31 peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

32 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
