17 **AN ACT to Provide Staggered Expiration**
18 **Dates for Terms of Inland Fisheries and**
19 **Wildlife Advisory Council Members.**

21 **Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts of the Legislature
22 do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment
23 unless enacted as emergencies; and

24 Whereas, present law provides that all members of the
25 council enjoy the same term of appointment; and

26 Whereas, the terms of 5 of the 7 members of the council
27 are due to expire simultaneously, causing too great a
28 turnover of council members at one time; and

29 Whereas, the expiration of those terms is due to occur
30 before this legislation would otherwise take effect, unless
31 enacted as an emergency, requiring the appointment of new
32 members according to present law thereby perpetuating the
33 problem; and
