A, §47, is repealed and the following 17 18 enacted in its place: On the effective date of this paragraph each person, 19 20 association or corporation licensed to conduct a race meet 21 under this chapter shall pay to the Treasurer of State, to 22 be credited to the General Fund of the State, a sum equal to 23 .70% of the total contributions of regular wagers and 3.80% 24 the total contributions of exotic wagers to all 25 pari-mutuel pools conducted or made at any race or race meet 26 licensed under this chapter. Beginning January 1, 1983, 27 each person, association or corporation licensed to conduct 28 a race meet under this chapter shall pay to the Treasurer of 29 State, to be credited to the General Fund of the State, a sum equal to .50% of the total contributions of regular wagers and 2.27% of the total contributions of exotic wagers 30 31 32 to all pari-mutuel pools conducted or made at any race or race meet licensed under this chapter. Each licensee shall 33 34 calculate on an annual basis the difference between the sum 35 paid by him pursuant to this paragraph, as it then existed,

for calendar year 1981 and the sum paid by him pursuant to

this paragraph for each succeeding calendar year. One-half

of this difference shall be used for the purpose of supple-

3 4	Further amend the bill by renumbering section 3 to be section 4 .

6 7 8 9	The anticipated reduction in General Fund revenues as a result of the enactment of section 3, which lowers in 2 stages the rate of the general tax on the total handle, is \$65,000 for fiscal year 1981-82 and \$329,264 for fiscal year 1982-83.
11	STATEMENT OF FACT
12 13 14 15 16 17 18 19	The purpose of this amendment is to lower in 2 stages the rate of the general tax on the total handle. The new section 3 will require that all harness racing tracks and all agricultural societies which conduct pari-mutuel harness racing meets use one-half of their annual tax savings, as measured against their 1981 payments, to increase the amount of purses paid. In addition, this amendment adds a fiscal note and corrects a reference.
