15 16 17	AN ACT to Provide for Identifying Seed Potatoes.
18	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
19	7 MRSA §2105 is enacted to read:
20	§2105. Seed potatoes to be labeled
21 22 23	All seed potatoes exported from this State to Canada or imported to this State from Canada shall be in 75-pound or 100-pound new burlap bags marked "FOR SEED USE ONLY."
24	STATEMENT OF FACT
25 26 27	This bill provides for identifying seed potatoes going to or coming from Canada. It will help stop the practice of Canadian potatoes entering the United States in bulk

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1 quantities labeled as "seed" and then being repackaged in2 bags and sold as "tablestock."

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
