AN ACT to Require Safety Information
with Wood Stoves and Furnaces.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

25 MRSA §2465 is enacted to read:

§2465. Safety instruction manuals

1. Instruction manual provided. Any person who sells a wood, coal or other solid fuel stove or furnace in retail trade shall provide the buyer at the time of sale with an approved instruction manual for its safe installation and operation. The instruction manual is subject to approval by the State Fire Marshal and shall contain recommended clearances the same as those prescribed in the then current edition of National Fire Protection Association Code #211, "The Standards of Chimneys, Fireplaces, Vents and Solid Fuel Burning Appliances." In the event the manufacturer does not supply an adequate instruction manual, an authorized publication by the State Fire Marshal may be provided instead.
