16 **AN ACT to Extend the Time for the Appor-**
17 **tionment of County Taxes.**

19 **Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts of the Legislature
20 do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment
21 unless enacted as emergencies; and

22 Whereas, all county budgets may not be enacted in time
23 to permit the apportionment of county taxes in March as cur-
24 rently required by law; and

25 Whereas, the time of apportionment of 1982 county taxes
26 needs to be extended; and

27 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these
28 facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Consti-
29 tution of Maine and require the following legislation as
30 immediately necessary for the preservation of the public
31 peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

32 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
