6 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 2097, L.D. 2031, Bill,
7 "AN ACT to Revise the Charter of the Brunswick Sewer Dis-
8 trict."

9 Amend the bill in Part 3, section 25, by inserting at
10 the end the following underlined sentence:

11 'If any sewer line of the district crosses the property or
12 line of any railroad corporation, the procedure shall be the
13 same as stated in this section, except that the Department
14 of Transportation shall be substituted for the Public Utili-
15 ties Commission.'

16 Further amend the bill in Part 4, section 34, subsec-
17 tion 1, in the 6th and 7th lines (page 11, lines 3 and 4 in
18 L. D.) by striking out everything after the underlined words
19 "have agreed to participate" and before the period.

20 Further amend the bill in Part 5, section 43, by strik-
21 ing out all of the 2nd underlined paragraph and inserting in
22 its place the following:

23 'A minimum of one notice shall be carried in a paid
24 advertisement at least 14 days prior to the hearing, except
25 in those instances where 2 notices are required by this
26 charter, in which case one advertisement shall be carried at
27 least 14 days and a 2nd advertisement at least 7 days prior
28 to the date of the hearing.'

29 STATEMENT OF FACT

30 This amendment provides the procedure in case the sewer
31 line crosses a railroad. It also includes 2 technical
32 changes.
