purpose of this bill is to eliminate the exposure to civil and criminal liability of towns that, for reasons, still do not have disposal facilities for solid domestic and commercial waste that comport Department of Environmental Protection standards. Several small towns, because of their geographical location, topography, small population and economy still do not have acceptable solid waste disposal facilities. As long as town's efforts to comply with the law have been, and continue to be, reasonable, this bill prevents any legal action from being initiated and any fines from being imposed due to the continuing nature of the town's violation of the law.
