16 **AN ACT to Eliminate Discrimination in**
17 **Cases of Prostitution.**

19 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

20 **Sec. 1. 17-A MRSA §851, sub-§1-A is enacted to read:**

21 1-A. "Engages a prostitute" means providing or agree-
22 ing to provide, either to the person whose prostitution is
23 sought or to a 3rd person, pecuniary benefit in return for
24 sexual intercourse or a sexual act as defined in section
25 251;

26 **Sec. 2. 17-A MRSA §853-B is enacted to read:**

27 §853-B. Engaging a prostitute

28 1. A person is guilty of engaging a prostitute if he
29 engages a prostitute within the meaning of section 851, sub-
30 section 1-A.
