## STATEMENT OF FACT

22 The purposes of this bill are to:

23 1. Treat fairly those individuals who had already 24 working toward their journeyman electrician's begun or 25 when the Legislature stiffened license relimited license 26 quirements last year. This bill allows these people to obtain their license under the same terms and conditions as 27 existed when they began working toward their license; and 28

29 2. Correct inadvertent technical errors in present30 law.
