## STATE OF MAINE SENATE 110TH LEGISLATURE SECOND REGULAR SESSION

6 SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to Committee Amendment "A" to 7 S.P. 906, L.D. 2048, Bill, "AN ACT to Protect the Atlantic 8 Salmon Fishery in the Lower Penobscot River from Veazie to 9 the Southernmost Point of Verona Island."

10 Amend the amendment by striking out everything after 11 the title and inserting in its place the following:

12 'Amend the bill by striking out everything after the 13 enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

14 **38 MRSA §418-A** is enacted to read:

15 §418-A. Protection of the lower Penobscot River

16 1. Findings. The Legislature finds that the lower Penobscot River is a unique and valuable natural resource. 17 The lower Penobscot River serves as an example to the Nation 18 19 that good public policy carefully implemented can restore 20 and preserve our natural resources. The river has sup-21 ported, and is again beginning to support, the greatest run 22 of Atlantic salmon in North America, providing a unique 23 fishing opportunity for Maine residents. The Legislature declares that the preservation and restoration of the lower 24 Penobscot River is of the highest priority. 25

2. Prohibition. To protect water quality and aquatic resources, fisheries and fishing opportunities, and as an exercise of the public trust of the State, no person, firm, 26 27 28 29 corporation, municipality or other legal entity may erect, 30 operate, maintain or use any dam on that portion of the 31 Penobscot River downstream from the Bangor Hydroelectric Company Dam located at Veazie to the southernmost point of 32 33 Verona Island for any purpose not previously authorized by act, resolve or operation of law, unless specifically 34 35 authorized by the Legislature.

## STATEMENT OF FACT

8 This amendment simplifies and clarifies the language of 9 the committee amendment.

10 The amendment is intended not to infringe on any exist-11 ing legal rights, but requires specific legislative approval 12 for expansion of any rights for hydroelectric generation on 13 the lower Penobscot River.
