STATE OF MAINE
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-TWO
AN ACT to Amend Charters of Various Water Districts Organized Under the Private and Special Laws Including Milbridge and Strong.
Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
Sec. 1. P&SL 1913, c. 25, $\S 6$, 2nd \P is repealed and the following enacted in its place:
Each member shall receive compensation as established in accordance with the Revised Statutes, Title 35, section 3223.
Sec. 2. P&SL 1981, c.55, §6, 1st sentence is amended to read:
All of the affairs of the district shall be managed by a board of 3 5 trustees who shall be chosen as hereinafter provided.
Sec. 3. P&SL 1981, c. 55, §6, 2nd ¶, 1st and 2nd sentences are amended to read:

As soon as may be after the acceptance of this Act as hereinafter provided, the municipal officers of Milbridge shall appoint 3 5 trustees of the district to hold office as follows: One Two to serve until the first annual election of municipal officers following the acceptance of this one 2 to serve until the 2nd annual election of municipal officers following the acceptance; and one to serve until the 3rd annual election of municipal officers following such acceptance. At each annual election of municipal officers, beginning with the first annual election of municipal cers after the acceptance of this Act, as their terms expire, a trustee one or 2 trustees as appropriate shall be elected by ballot to serve until the annual election of municipal officers occurring 3 years thereafter and successor is their successors are appointed or elected and qualified.

17 Sec. 4. P&SL 1981, c. 55, §6, 2nd ¶, last sentence is amended to read:

If at At any annual election there shall exist a vacancy in an unexpired term, the voters of the district shall cast their ballot for as many candidates as there are offices to be filled, including vacancies in any unexpired terms.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill increases the number of trustees in the Milbridge Water District from 3 to 5.

The bill also conforms the charter of the Strong Water District to Public Law 1981, chapter 447, which allows trustees compensation to be set by the municipal officers upon recommendation by the trustees. The amount is recorded in the bylaws and with the Secretary of State. Present compensation would stay in effect until changed.

This bill is reported by the Joint Standing Committee on Public Utilities in accordance with Public Law 1981, chapter 447, section 2.
