16 **AN ACT to Remove Restrictions Preventing**
17 **Persons Elected to the Legislature from Re-**
18 **ceiving Certain Benefits.**

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

21 **5 MRSA §1123**, as last amended by PL 1979, c. 663, §16
22 and 17, is further amended by adding at the end a new para-
23 graph to read:

24 Any person who is a recipient of a state retirement
25 allowance and who is reemployed in any capacity in which he
26 would otherwise be eligible to be a participating member of
27 the system may, as of January 1, 1983, become a member of
28 the system providing that his new service shall entitle that
29 person to new benefits. Any new benefits shall be only such
30 benefits as one earned on the new service and shall not
31 entitle any person so reemployed to statutory minimum bene-
32 fits on that service.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

2 The purpose of this bill is to permit persons who are
3 receiving a state retirement allowance to become members of
4 the Maine State Retirement System if they are reemployed and
5 entitled to new benefits.

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
