21 **Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts of the Legislature
22 do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment
23 unless enacted as emergencies; and

24 Whereas, ambiguities exist in the law relating to the
25 development, design and registration of trademarks by the
26 Commissioner of Marine Resources; and

27 Whereas, these uncertainties make it extremely diffi-
28 cult to interpret legislative intent in this area; and

29 Whereas, it is vitally necessary that these uncertain-
30 ties and confusion be resolved in order to prevent any
31 injustice or hardship on the citizens of Maine; and
