16 AN ACT to Amend the Charter of Coburn
17 Classical Institute.

19 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

20 **P&SL 1901, c. 333, §1 is amended to read:**

21 **Sec. 1.** Nathaniel Butler, Franklin W. Johnson, George
22 D. B. Pepper, Horace Purinton, Leslie C. Cornish, Edwin C.
23 Whittemore, Horatio R. Dunham and Cyrus W. Davis are hereby
24 created a corporation by the name of Trustees of Coburn
25 Classical Institute, for the purpose of maintaining a liter-
26 ary institution in the city of Waterville with all the
27 powers of similar corporations, including the power to make
28 and establish ~~by-laws~~ bylaws and regulations for the manage-
29 ment of its affairs and the proper government of the insti-
30 tution.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment to the Charter of Colburn Classical Institute removes a restriction that the institute be located in the city of Waterville. This will enable the institution to operate in other quarters in the city of Waterville.

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
