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SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to S.P. 931, L.D. 2076, Bill,

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"AN ACT to Amend the Maine Implementing Act with Respect to

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the Houlton Band of Maliseet Indians."

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Amend the bill in section 2 in that part designated

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"§6205-A." in subsection 1 is amended by adding at the end

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the following:

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'D. No land or natural resources may be acquired by

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the secretary for the Houlton Band of Maliseet Indians

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within the unorganized territories without prior

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approval of the Legislature.'

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The purpose of this amendment is to require prior

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approval of the Legislature before any purchase of land or

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resources within the unorganized territories. This will

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serve to put the public on notice and provide an opportunity

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to be heard on any such transactions.
