17 18 19 20 21 22 23 24 25 26	The purpose of this amendment is to require prior approval of the Legislature or county commissioners before any land or resources can be purchased by the Houlton Band of Maliseet Indians in the unorganized territories. This amendment thereby affords to the citizens of the unorganized territories the same protection, that is, prior approval of the purchase by a legislative body, that the bill currently gives to people living in cities, towns, villages and plantations. This prior approval process will serve to put the citizens in the unorganized territories on notice and
