15 16 17 18	<u>'2. Assistants.</u> The commissioner may appoint, on a temporary basis, as assistant game wardens, in accordance with rules and regulations established by the Personnel Board.
19 20	Further amend the Bill by striking out all of section 19.
21 22	Further amend the Bill by renumbering sections 20 to 37 to be sections 19 to 36.
23	STATEMENT OF FACT
24 25 26	This amendment makes a technical change in the title of the bill, gives the commissioner more flexibility in appointing assistant game wardens and removes a proposed
