16 **AN ACT to Adjust Salaries of Officers**
17 **of Knox and Hancock Counties for 1981.**

19 **Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts of the Legislature
20 do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment
21 unless enacted as emergencies; and

22 Whereas, salary revisions for officers of Knox and
23 Hancock Counties were inadvertently omitted from the 1981
24 county salaries' bill; and

25 Whereas, the adjustments to salaries for officers of
26 Knox and Hancock Counties for 1981 must be enacted before
27 salary changes for 1982 are enacted; and

28 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these
29 facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Consti-
30 tution of Maine and require the following legislation as
31 immediately necessary for the preservation of the public
32 peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
