HOUSE AMENDMENT "E" to H.P. 2233, L.D. 2091, Bill,
"AN ACT to Adjust Levels of Compensation for Constitutional
Officers, Members of the Legislature and the Senate Secretary
and House Clerk."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of section 5 and
inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 5. 3 MRSA §2, 4th ¶, as repealed and replaced by
PL 1975, c. 750, §1, is amended by adding at the end 2 new
sentences to read:

The additional compensation to be paid to Senate and House
chairmen of joint standing committees who are not members of
leadership shall be set by the Legislative Council in accordance
with a 3-tiered system of payment based on, but not limited to,
considerations of experience of the chairmen and committee
workload. In no case may the pay differential exceed regular
compensation by more than 12 1/2%.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this amendment is to direct the Legislative
Council to establish a 3-tiered payment system for House and
Senate committee chairmen to be based, in part, on the
experience of the chairmen and committee workload. In no
case may this additional compensation exceed regular compensation
by more than 12 1/2%.
