15 16 17 18 19 20 21 22 23	Each member of the Senate and House of Representatives shall receive \$25 \$35 for every day's attendance when meetings or daily sessions are held, a meal and housing allowance in the amount of \$35 for each day in attendance at such meetings or daily sessions and for each day he occupies overnight accommodations away from home either immediately preceding or immediately following attendance at daily sessions of the Legislature and actual daily mileage allowances which shall be paid at the same rate paid to state employees.
