SENATE AMENDMENT " B" to H.P. 2233, L.D. 2091, Bill,  
7 "AN ACT to Adjust Levels of Compensation for Constitutional  
8 Officers, Members of the Legislature and the Senate Secre-  
9 tary and House Clerk."

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 4.

11

Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 8  
12 and inserting in its place the following:

13

'Sec. 8. 3 MRSA §2, 9th ¶, 2nd sentence, as amended by  
14 PL 1979, c. 544, §4, is further amended to read:

15

Each member of the Senate and House of Representatives shall  
16 receive ~~\$25~~ \$35 for every day's attendance when meetings or  
17 daily sessions are held, a meal and housing allowance in the  
18 amount of \$35 for each day in attendance at such meetings or  
19 daily sessions and for each day he occupies overnight accom-  
20 modations away from home either immediately preceding or  
21 immediately following attendance at daily sessions of the  
22 Legislature and actual daily mileage allowances which shall  
23 be paid at the same rate paid to state employees.'

Further amend the bill in section 15 by striking out  
25 all of the last 3 lines and inserting in their place the  
26 following:

27

'Personal Services \$440,680'

Further amend the bill by renumbering the sections to  
29 read consecutively.
