6 HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 2234, L.D. 2092, Bill,
7 "AN ACT Concerning Maine Emergency Medical Services."

8 Amend the bill in section 2 in that part designated
9 "§82." in subsection 1 by striking out all of the 2nd para-
10 graph and inserting in its place the following:

11 'Failure of an ambulance, ambulance service or first
12 responder service to obtain licensure shall make that indi-
13 vidual or organization subject to a fine of not more than
14 \$500 or by imprisonment for not more than 6 months, unless
15 other penalties are specified.'

16 Further amend the bill in section 2 in that part desig-
17 nated "§88." in subsection 2, paragraph C, in the first and
18 2nd lines (page 10, lines 38 and 39 in L.D.) by striking out
19 the underlined words "and renewed"

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STATEMENT OF FACT

21 This amendment exempts an emergency medical services'
22 person from criminal liability for failure to be licensed,
23 as is presently the law. Since the bill has given the board
24 discretionary power to make recommendations on renewed
25 licenses, this amendment removes the requirement that the
26 board review applications for renewed licenses.
