22 23 24	Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
25 26 27	Whereas, the Health Facilities Information Disclosure Act will be automatically repealed on July 1, 1982, unless sooner extended; and
28 29 30 31	Whereas, the informed development of public policy relating to health care requires that the State regularly assemble and analysis information pertaining to health care costs; and
32 33 34	Whereas, the rising costs of health care and services provided by health care facilities require the continued review of proposed hospital budgets; and

16	This chapter shall be repealed on July 1, $\frac{1982}{1983}$.
