STATEMENT OF FACT

The purposes of this amendment are:

1. To strike from the bill 3 provisions that would
undedicate revenues from licensing fees in the areas of:

A. Hospitals, nursing homes and other health care
institutions;

3 B. Eating and lodging places and recreational and
4 camping facilities; and

5 C. The practice of electrology; and

6 2. To delete all those changes to the statutory provi-
7 sions dealing with hearing aid dealers and fitters. The
8 changes proposed in the bill for this industry have the
9 effect of overregulating it as well as raising the annual
10 licensing fee by 400%.
