12 13	'Further amend the bill in Part A by striking out all of sections 12 and 20.'
14 15	Further amend the amendment by inserting after the 5th paragraph after the title the following:
16 17	'Further amend the bill in Part A by striking out all of section 47.'
18 19 20	Further amend the amendment by striking out all of the last 3 paragraphs before the Statement of Fact and inserting in their place the following:
21 22	'Further amend the bill in Part A by striking out all of sections 53 to 80.
23 24	Further amend the bill in Part A by renumbering the sections to read consecutively.'
25	STATEMENT OF FACT
26	The purposes of this amendment are:
27 28	1. To strike from the bill 3 provisions that would undedicate revenues from licensing fees in the areas of:
29 30	A. Hospitals, nursing homes and other health care institutions;

3 B. Eating and lodging places and recreational and 4 camping facilities; and

5 C. The practice of electrology; and

6 2. To delete all those changes to the statutory provi-7 sions dealing with hearing aid dealers and fitters. The 8 changes proposed in the bill for this industry have the 9 effect of overregulating it as well as raising the annual 10 licensing fee by 400%.
