2 STATEMENT OF FACT

This resolve authorizes Washington County Vocational-Technical Institute to lease the vessel, Fish Finder, subject to the conditions of this resolve. It also establishes a dedicated account to be used for the maintenance of the vessel and to purchase necessary equipment and insurance.

The vessel was acquired from the Federal Government, refurbished and put into operation to provide practical fishing experience to students enrolled in Washington County Vocational-Technical Institute's Commercial Fishing Program at Eastport, Maine. All of the funds for the acquisition. refurbishing and delivery of the vessel were generated through private and federal funds. Washington Vocational-Technical Institute's 1982-83 budget appropriations for continued operation of the Fish Finder are quate to cover the insurance premiums, maintenance and oper-This ating costs. resolve authorizes Washington County Vocational-Technical Institute lease vessel to generate sufficient funds to cover the necessary costs.
